## U.S. COAST GUARD DIRECTOR OF OPERATIONAL LOGISTICS (DOL) NORFOLK, VIRGINIA

**CITATION:** 

"For meritorious service from May 2019 to November 2020 while providing critical support to Coast Guard missions throughout Atlantic Area. In May 2019, the Department of Homeland Security responded to an unprecedented migration and humanitarian crisis along the United States Southwest Border. DOL provided instrumental support to partner agencies by mobilizing 900 active duty and reserve members to aid in the safe and orderly processing of migrants. Simultaneously, DOL provided mission-critical support to Atlantic Area's response to Hurricane DORIAN, which impacted Haiti, the Bahamas, and the United States eastern seaboard. DOL's nimble response posture supported two Coast Guard Districts, four major cutters, and aids to navigation vessels. Furthermore, DOL's coordinated deployment of 20 deployable support elements, including Logistics, Damage Assessment, Repair, Personnel, Legal, Medical, Critical Incident Stress Management (CISM), and Vessel Support Teams, enabled operational forces to sortie, respond, and recover from the dangerous weather event. Moreover, DOL's support to operational forces during the coronavirus (COVID) pandemic enabled sustained mission effectiveness across the Atlantic Area fleet, resulting in the procurement of personal protective equipment (PPE) and deliverance of noteworthy amounts of mission support resources, services, and coordinated support across five Atlantic Area Districts and over 40 operational commands. The response posture, partnering, and effective integration eased the concerns and enhanced the effectiveness of Coast Guard forces responding to 12 hurricanes during the 2020 Hurricane Season. DOL dispatched 13 Damage Assessment Teams, 10 repair teams, five Logistic Support Elements, and the Mobile Support Unit, with an additional 12 Personnel Support Teams, three Legal Service Teams, and one CISM team to assist members coping with displacement and property damage. The devotion to duty and outstanding performance demonstrated by the U.S. Coast Guard Director of Operational Logistics are in keeping with the highest traditions of the United States Coast Guard."
